



# REGIONAL LITTER AND ILLEGAL DUMPING PLAN

Litter and illegal dumping pose a significant problem for Barwon South West communities in terms of impacts to our environment, community wellbeing and the associated clean-up costs.

Barwon South West Waste and Resource Recovery Group (BSWWRRG) has received funding from Sustainability Victoria to develop a **Regional Litter and Illegal Dumping Plan** (the Litter Plan). The purpose of the Litter Plan is to identify the top five litter and illegal dumping issues for the region and outline key actions that will address these issues.
